**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER VII, TRAFFIC, OF AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND ENACTING THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LINDEN, 1999," PASSED NOVEMBER 23, 1999 AND APPROVED NOVEMBER 24, 1999, AND AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LINDEN:**

Section 1. That Chapter VII, Traffic, shall be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

Chapter VII, Traffic

**7-33 HANDICAPPED PARKING REGULATIONS**

**7-33.1A Handicapped Parking On-Street**

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Spaces</u>	<u>No. of Location</u>
<b>ADD:</b> 909 Baldwin Avenue	1	On the southwesterly sideline of Baldwin Avenue, 67 feet more or less northwesterly from the projection of the northwesterly curbline of Center Street in front of 909 Baldwin Avenue for a length of 22 feet. The aforesaid space is specifically reserved and designated for a vehicle for Tyrone L. Ross to be identified by license plate number and placard to be issued by the City, and no other vehicle bearing or displaying handicapped license plates and/or placards, or not, shall be permitted to park in such space.

Section 2. The remaining provisions of the Chapter hereby amended and supplemented shall continue in full force and effect to the same extent as if herein fully repeated.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, provision, clause, or portion of this ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall not affect the remaining sections, subsections, provisions, clauses, or portions, which shall be deemed severable therefrom.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect in the manner provided by law.
