| <b>49-77</b><br>(CH 5-2)   | <b>PET WASTE</b><br>All pet owners/keepers are required to immediately and properly dispose of their pet's solid waste deposited on any property, public or private, not owned or possessed by that person. Exempt: Disability assistance animals  | Not To Exceed \$1250<br>Imprisonment in County Jail up to 90 days or 90 days Community Service in discretion of Municipal Judge                  | Police<br>Bd of Health                | 9/21/2005       |
| <b>49-78</b><br>(CH 3-1)   | <b>LITTER CONTROL</b><br>Unlawful for any person to throw, drop, discard or otherwise place any litter of any nature upon public/private property other than in a litter receptacle, or having done so, to allow such litter to remain.  | Not To Exceed \$1250<br>Imprisonment in County Jail up to 90 days or 90 days Community Service in discretion of Municipal Judge                  | Police<br>Public Works                | 9/21/2005       |
| <b>49-79</b><br>(CH 16-14) | <b>CONTAINERIZED YARD WASTE</b><br>The owner or occupant of any property, or any employee or contractor of such owner or occupant engaged to provide lawn care or landscaping services, shall not sweep, rake, blow or otherwise place yard waste, unless the yard waste is containerized, in the street. If yard waste that is not containerized is placed in the street, the party responsible for placement of yard waste must remove the yard waste from the street or said party shall be deemed in violation of this ordinance.  | Not To Exceed \$1250<br>Imprisonment in County Jail up to 90 days or 90 days Community Service in discretion of Municipal Judge                  | Police<br>Public Works                | 9/21/2005       |
| <b>49-80</b><br>(CH 19-2)  | <b>WILDLIFE FEEDING</b><br>No person shall feed, in any public park or on any other property owned or operated by the City of Linden, any wildlife, excluding confined wildlife (i.e. wildlife confined in zoos, parks or rehabilitation centers, or unconfined wildlife at environmental education centers).  | Not To Exceed \$1250<br>Imprisonment in County Jail up to 90 days or 90 days Community Service in discretion of Municipal Judge                  | Police<br>Mun Officials               | 9/21/2005       |
| <b>49-81</b><br>(CH 3-50)  | <b>IMPROPER DISPOSAL OF WASTE</b><br>The spilling, dumping, or disposal of materials other than stormwater to the municipal separate storm sewer system operated by the City of Linden is prohibited. The spilling, dumping, or disposal of materials other than stormwater in such a manner as to cause the discharge of pollutants to the municipal separate storm sewer system is also prohibited. Exempt: Water line flushing, Uncontaminated ground water, Air conditioning condensate, Irrigation water, Flows from Springs..., Residential Car Washing, Sidewalk...Wash Water, Flows from Fire Fighting Activities, Equipment Rinsing | Minimum \$2500<br>Not To Exceed \$10000.<br>Imprisonment of 90 days in County Jail or 90 days Community Service in discretion of Municipal Judge | Police<br>Public Works<br>Engineering | 9/21/2005       |
| <b>49-82</b><br>(CH 26-16) | <b>ILLICIT CONNECTION</b><br>No person shall discharge or cause to be discharged through an illicit connection to the municipal separate storm sewer system operated by the City of Linden any domestic sewerage, non-contact cooling water, process wastewater, or other industrial waste (other than stormwater).  | \$1250<br>Imprisonment in County Jail up to 90 days or 90 days Community Service in discretion of Municipal Judge                                | Police<br>Public Works<br>Engineering | 9/21/2005       |

| <b>49-83</b><br>(CH 16-13) | <b>YARD WASTE COLLECTION PROGRAM</b><br>Sweeping, raking, blowing or otherwise placing yard waste that is not containerized at the curb or along the street is only allowed during the seven (7) days prior to a scheduled and announced collection, and shall not be placed closer than 10 feet from any storm drain inlet. Placement of such yard waste at the curb or along the street at any other time or in any other manner is a violation of this ordinance. If such placement of yard waste occurs, the party responsible for placement of the yard waste must remove the yard waste from the street or said party shall be deemed in violation of this ordinance. | Not To Exceed \$2500<br>Imprisonment in County Jail up to 90 days or 90 days Community Service in discretion of Municipal Judge | Police<br>Public Works                        | 9/21/2005       |
| <b>54-55</b><br>(CH 26-18) | <b>REFUSE CONTAINERS / DUMPSTERS</b><br>Any person who owns, leases or otherwise uses a refuse container or dumpster must ensure that such container or dumpster does not leak or otherwise discharge liquids, semi-liquids or solids to the municipal separate storm sewer system(s) operated by the City of Linden.   | Not To Exceed \$500 per Container per Day   | Police<br>Public Works<br>Bd of Health        | 8/18/2010       |
| <b>54-56</b><br>(CH 26-19) | <b>PRIVATE STORM DRAIN INLET RETROFITTING</b><br>Any person in control of private property (residential single family excluded) shall authorize the repaving, repairing (excluding repair of potholes), resurfacing, reconstructing or altering any surface that is in direct contact with an existing storm drain inlet on that property unless the storm drain inlet either: a. already meets the design standard to control passage of solid and floatable materials; or b. is retrofitted or replaced to meet the standard in subsection 26-19.4 prior to the completion of the project.  | Not To Exceed \$500 Per Inlet   | Police<br>Engineering<br>Construction<br>Code | 8/18/2010       |
