AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER VII, TRAFFIC, OF AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND ENACTING THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LINDEN, 1999," PASSED NOVEMBER 23, 1999 AND APPROVED NOVEMBER 24, 1999, AND AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LINDEN:

Section 1. That Chapter VII, Traffic, shall be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

Chapter VII, Traffic

7-33 HANDICAPPED PARKING REGULATIONS

7-33.1A Handicapped Parking On-Street

<b>ADD:</b> 110 West 16 <sup>th</sup> Street	1		On the northwesterly sideline of West 16 <sup>th</sup> Street, 120 feet more or less southwesterly from the projection of the southwesterly curblineline of Winans Avenue in front of 110 West 16 <sup>th</sup> Street for a length of 22 feet. The aforesaid space is specifically reserved and designated for a vehicle for Cynthia Dudley-Hayes to be identified by license plate number and placard to be issued by the City, and no other vehicle bearing or displaying handicapped license plates and/or placards, or not, shall be permitted to park in such space.
<b>ADD:</b> 2021 Von Spiegel Place	1		On the northwesterly side of Von Spiegel Place, 63 feet more or less southwesterly from the projection of the southwesterly curblineline of McCandless Place in front of 2021 Von Spiegel Place and continuing for a length of 22 feet in a southwesterly direction. The aforesaid space is specifically reserved and designated for a vehicle for Kristi DePalma to be identified by license plate number and placard to be issued by the City, and no other vehicle bearing or displaying handicapped license plates and/or placards, or not, shall be permitted to park in such space.

Section 2. The remaining provisions of the Chapter hereby amended and supplemented shall continue in full force and effect to the same extent as if herein fully repeated.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, provision, clause, or portion of this ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall not affect the remaining sections, subsections, provisions, clauses, or portions, which shall be deemed severable therefrom.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect in the manner provided by law.
