- 4. The poster can be made from any drawing paper material, ie. construction paper, sketchbook paper, poster board paper, etc.
- 5. Any drawing material can be used on the poster: chalk, color pencils, crayons, pencils, markers, paint, etc.
- 6. <u>Theme:</u> Black American Coaches. Please choose a Black NFL, NBA, or MLB Coach.
- 7. All posters must be submitted to the <u>John T. Gregorio Center</u>, <u>330 Helen Street</u> on or before <u>February 17th</u>, <u>2023</u>. The John T. Gregorio Center hours: Monday thru Friday, 8:30am-4:30pm.
- 8. Posters will be judged on Thursday, February 23, 2023.
