Black History Poster Contest

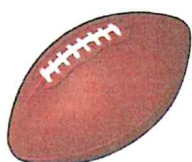
All Linden students from grades 6 through 12

Rules and Regulations:

1. Any student in grades 6 through 12.
2. All entries must have full name, school, teacher, grade, and parent/guardian cell phone number printed on a blank index card taped to the back.
3. All posters must be 9"x12". Posters exceeding this size will be disqualified.
4. The poster can be made from any drawing paper material, ie. construction paper, sketchbook paper, poster board paper, etc.
5. Any drawing material can be used on the poster: chalk, color pencils, crayons, pencils, markers, paint, etc.
6. **Theme: Black American Coaches. Please choose a Black NFL, NBA, or MLB Coach.**
7. All posters must be submitted to the John T. Gregorio Center, 330 Helen Street on or before February 17th, 2023. The John T. Gregorio Center hours: Monday thru Friday, 8:30am-4:30pm.
8. Posters will be judged on Thursday, **February 23, 2023.**
9. 1st place winners from each school will be contacted. First place prizes will be available for pick up at the John T. Gregorio Recreation Center with a photo taken on Friday, **February 24, 2023.**
