- 4. The poster can be made from any drawing paper material, ie. construction paper, sketchbook paper, poster board paper, etc.
- 5. Any drawing material can be used on the poster: chalk, color pencils, crayons, pencils, markers, paint, etc.
- 6. Theme: Black American Disney Characters
- 7. All posters must be submitted to the John T. Gregorio Center, 330 Helen Street on or before **February 29, 2024.** The John T. Gregorio Center hours: Monday thru Friday, 8:30am-4:30pm.
- 8. Posters will be judged on Friday, March 1, 2024.
- 9. All posters from each participant will be displayed at the John T. Gregorio Center.
- 10. Elementary art teachers will announce the winners at school on Monday, March 4, 2024.
- 11. First place winners from each school will be presented with a prize along with a photo taken from a Linden Recreation staff member on Tuesday, **March 5, 2024**, at the John T. Gregorio Center.
