Application for "It Takes A Village" Student Public Service Announcement (PSA) Video Contest

Criteria:

The Mayor of Linden, in partnership with the Linden Public Schools, working together as part of the "It Takes A Village" initiative, solicits student-made Public Service Announcement videos on the following topic: "Keeping Our Schools Safe For All." The content of the PSA should be focused on ways to positively enhance school security taken from the student perspective.

Submissions will be accepted from students in the Linden Public Schools with prizes going to the best PSA from each level; one prize for high school, one for the middle school, and one for the elementary schools. All submissions, whether earning a prize or not, may be used on Channel 36 and other media outlets to raise awareness of school security and to influence good behavior.

The High School and Middle School submissions should be a minimum of 2 minutes, but not more than 5 minutes. Elementary submissions should be a minimum of 1 minute, but not more than 3 minutes.

Submission deadline: Friday, March 1, 2024

<u>Procedures</u>: Student applicants (either individual students or teams of students) should submit their completed work to their building principal by the established due date. A City-organized review committee will view all submissions to ensure consistency with the application criteria. Those submissions meeting the criteria will be sent to a City-organized selection committee to determine prizes. Prize winners will be recognized at a future City Council meeting.

Prizes: High School: \$1,000; Middle School: \$750; Elementary School: \$500

<u>Selection date</u>: Award recipients will be invited to attend the March 2024 Board of Education meeting. Use of the PSAs on various media outlet will follow the awards.
